USDA: US exports 572,500 tons of wood pellets in May

The U.S. exported 572,500 tons of wood pellets in May, up from 528,200 in April. The U.S. exports of wood pellets in May were 10% higher than in April, according to data released by the USDA on July 2.

33 House members urge Trump to reject pay-raise hikes

A bipartisan group of 33 members of the U.S. House of Representatives on July 2 sent a letter to President Trump urging the administration to reject 13 pay-raise bills that have been filed in an attempt to circumvent a recent court ruling.

DOE selects 7 projects for performance-advantaged biofuels

The U.S. Department of Energy on July 2 announced the selection of seven projects totaling \$1.5 billion to conduct research and development to accelerate the commercialization of advanced biofuels.

Waste-derived fuel pellets successfully tested for 150-month plant

BP&C Atlanta Energy has completed industrial scale verification testing of the waste-derived fuel pellets it plans to use as fuel at the 150-month Power Cycles facility in conversion. The company has also released an updated project timeline.

IRA predicts growth in renewable electricity generation

The U.S. Energy Information Administration reports projects electricity U.S. generation from renewable energy sources will reach 20 percent in 2020 and 32 percent in 2021, according to agency's latest short-term energy outlook, released July 7.

ETS Biogas, Enagis partner on biogas projects in Italy

ETS Biogas SA, a wholly owned subsidiary of Bienergy (2016), and Enagis on July 7 signed a MOU under which the two companies will share expertise and resources to expand decarbonation efforts starting in Italy and expanding throughout Europe.

Enagis, Carbon Sole partner on waste-to-energy projects in Ireland

Enagis, a technology supplier for gasification projects, announced on July 7 that it has signed a wholly owned subsidiary (Enagis) with Carbon Sole (Carbon Sole) to partner on waste-to-energy projects in Ireland.

Avista opens HPP for 120 MW of renewable capacity

Avista, a utility serving regions in Washington, Oregon and Idaho, announced on July 2 it is opening capacity from a new hydroelectric project (HPP) for up to 120 MW of power production. The project is among those under construction.

US: EPC provides COVID-19 extensions to non-dominant HPI projects

The U.S. government has announced that approvals to the non-dominant HPI projects will have an extra 14 months to complete projects delayed by COVID-19. The government also confirmed that a third deadline for the non-dominant HPI will open in July.

Ways2H issues with Ford, Borealis & Davison on waste-to-hydrogen plants

Ways2H Inc., a waste-to-hydrogen producer, and EPC company Ford, Borealis & Davison have announced a joint collaboration to design and build waste-to-hydrogen facilities in California and other U.S. locations.
